

At the Parish Council Forum held on 21st October, Cllr. Stephenson asked for expressions of interest from parishes to conduct a Community Speed Watch in their parish under item 7, Highways Update.

CSW schemes are a great way for the community to work in partnership with the police and authority to tackle speeding.

The CSW documents are currently being written so at this stage parishes are asked if:

- a) they would like to take part
- b) possible locations that would benefit from data being collected.

Full risk assessments, training and equipment will be provided by RCC.

Location: areas with a speed limit of no more than 40mph may be put forward for consideration (safety reasons) and where parishes are small, villages can combine together. 4 is suggested as a minimum number of volunteers necessary to be able to conduct a CSW but, within reason, there is no upper limit!

Expressions of interest need to be received by 2 December 2019.
